## INTRODUCTION

The Master of Entrepreneurship is a formal and holistic program to produce candidates with the entrepreneurial instinct and skills for innovative and creative endeavor. This program is designed for candidates from various educational backgrounds. The objective of this program is to produce entrepreneurs with essential entrepreneurial knowledge, skills and competencies. Candidates of this program will also be exposed to practical hands-on experience to exploit market opportunities as well as benefit from the networking.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- i. Candidate should have a Bachelor Degree with minimum CGPA of 3.00 on a 4-point scale from a local or international institution recognized by UPM or;
- ii. Work experience of at least one (1) year if CGPA is between 2.99 and 2.75 or;
- iii. Work experience of at least three (3) years if CGPA is between 2.749 and 2.50 or;
- iv. Work experience of at least five (5) years if CGPA is below 2.50; or
- v. Candidate with a professional qualification equivalent to a bachelor's degree with at least five (5) years working experience shall be considered.

## LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

International applicants whose first language is not English are required to submit an official Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International Language Testing System (IELTS) score. The requirements are at least a score of :

- i. 550 for TOEFL ; or
- ii. Band 6.0 for IELTS ; or
- iii. Level 109 for CIEP.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Candidates are required to complete a total of 43 credit hours of coursework. The total number of credit hours include program core courses (31 credit hours), elective courses (6 credit hours) and an entrepreneurship project (6 credits hours).

## DURATION OF STUDY & MODE OF DELIVERY

Candidates may complete the program within three to six semesters. The program is run on both full time and part time basis. It is delivered through an appropriate mix of classroom (night) lectures, entrepreneurship project, industry visit and networking, individual and team assignments, as well as case studies.
