INTRODUCTION

The Master of Finance program is a graduate program by coursework which is recognized at both national and international levels. The focus of this program is on Financial Engineering and Islamic Finance. Students are required to register for several courses and conduct a research project. Students pursuing the Master of Finance may complete the program between a minimum period of one and half years to a maximum period of three years.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The candidate should possess a:

- Bachelor's Degree or an equivalent qualification in a relevant field with a minimum CGPA of 3.000; or
- Bachelor's Degree or an equivalent qualification with a CGPA between 2.750 - 2.999 and a minimum of 1 year working experience in a relevant field; or
- Bachelor's Degree or an equivalent qualification with a CGPA between 2.500 - 2.749 and a minimum of 5 years working experience in a relevant field.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

International candidates whose first language is not English must obtain at least one of the following:

- Band 6.0 for IELTS (Academic Version); or
- Score 79-80 for TOEFL (Internet-based); or
- Band 4 for MUET; or
- Score 50 for PTE Academic; or
- Score 109 for CIEP at ELS Language Centre, UPM

Note: The validity period of the English Language Proficiency score should not be more than five years.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Credit Hours Requirement

Candidates are required to complete a total of 40 credit hours of coursework. The total credit hours include program core courses (27 credit hours), elective courses (6 credit hours) and Research Project (7 credit hours).

DURATION OF STUDY & MODE OF DELIVERY

Candidates may complete the program within three to six semesters (one and half to three years). The program is run on both part time and full time basis. It is delivered through an appropriate mix of classroom (night) lectures, case studies and individual or team assignments.
