Please be informed that UPM's announcement on teaching and learning activities (TnL) First Semester 2022/2023 (e-Hebahan Putra dated 1 August 2022) is referred to. In principle, all students are required to return to campus in the First Semester of 2022/2023.

The School of Business and Economics (SPE) will implement Teaching and Learning (TnL) on a hybrid basis until the 7th week. All local and international students in Malaysia are required to attend TnL from Week 1 to Week 7 physically. Online TnL only applies to international students who are in their respective countries.

However, from Week 8 onwards, TnL will only be held physically. Since all class activities are carried out face-to-face, it will seriously impact the carry mark of students who do not attend the classes. Therefore, students unable to attend TnL physically are highly advised to drop the course or postpone their studies.
