

# CLEAN OUR PLATE 13.0

Clean Our Plate project team from AIESEC in Universiti Putra Malaysia is a passionate bunch of young people stepping up to create an impact to their community, empowering high school and university students to take action in tackling the serious food waste issues in Malaysia. The organising committee consists of 6 youths who handled 11 volunteers, partnered with 7 like-minded professional partners in the field and made sure of the sustainability of the project.

Activities are conducted to educate public about food waste management knowledges include awareness video challenges, school exhibition, volunteering activities. employee workshop and physical fundraising. The volunteers also aware on the food insecurity faced by refugee communities and raise fund to support them by donating meals. The digital campaign was also run to spread awareness about food waste issues through 3 awareness video sharing. Throughout the entire project, Organising Committee members, Malaysian Youth Volunteers, and school students also went through trainings and preparation on food waste knowledge sharings. Besides that, 20kg of surplus food are saved through sustainable cooking conducted by Avosome. The total of 73 kg of food wastes had collected for repurposing purpose including 10kg expired corn flour, 25kg coffee ground from Gigi coffee and Zus coffee and 30kg used cooking oil, 8kg imperfect avocado and 20kg of food waste for composting workshop.

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CLEAN OUR PLATE 13.0 had ended successfully, thanks to the dedication of all the people involved, the volunteers that committed in this 4 weeks project played a crucial role in creating the lasting impact, alongside value-aligned partners which delivered insightful content as well as the organising committee that strive their best to ensure the experience of volunteers.
